WHEN DID THIS PROGRAM BEGIN?

The \$9.99 90 Day Generic Program began on Sunday, June 8, 2008.

The \$3.99 30 Day Generic Program began on Sunday, June 6, 2010.

HOW DOES THIS PROGRAM WORK?

ShopRite has selected and priced commonly prescribed generic drugs used for maintenance therapy at \$9.99 for a 90 day supply or \$3.99 for a 30 day supply based on commonly prescribed dosages.

ARE ALL GENERIC DRUGS INCLUDED IN THIS PROGRAM?

Not all generic drugs are included in this program. However, we have selected over 375 of today's commonly prescribed generic drugs.

WILL THIS LIST OF GENERIC DRUGS EVER CHANGE?

The list will be updated on an ongoing basis. Check back periodically to see what new drugs may be added.

DO I NEED TO SIGN UP FOR THIS PROGRAM?

No, there is absolutely nothing you need to do to participate in this program. No enrollment, membership, or hassles.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM?

CAN YOU BILL MY INSURANCE ALONG WITH THIS PROGRAM?

No. You can use either your insurance plan or the ShopRite Generic Drug Program if your prescription is for one of the generic drugs on the list (whichever is less expensive for you).
